<u>How To Get Here</u>	<ul> <li>By Air:</li> <li>We have used Vancouver Airport as the starting point for these instructions. From the south terminal of the Vancouver International Airport, you can fly to Port Hardy with:</li> <li>Pacific Coastal Airlines: Flies direct between Vancouver and Port Hardy.</li> <li>1-800-663-2872 www.pacificcoastal.com</li> <li>Note: Pacific Coastal flies from the (peaceful!) South Terminal at Vancouver International Airport. There is a regular shuttle bus from the main terminal and from the seaplane port. Allow at least 60 minutes from door to door, including check in time, to meet the required boarding and check in times.</li> <li>Town Taxi, Port Hardy: 250-949-7877</li> </ul>

If You Are Delayed and Emergency Contact	<ul> <li>Delays</li> <li>If for any reason you are delayed on the day that you are to meet the ship, please call us so that we can try to assist you in getting to the ship on time. Please note the ship cannot wait for passengers and small commercial vessels or float planes are usually relatively expensive options. These costs, should they be incurred, will be the sole responsibility of the passenger.</li> <li>Contact for Your Family in Emergency</li> <li>If there is a severe emergency at home while you are travelling, your family can use the contact info above to provide a message to you.</li> </ul>
<u>Travel Agent and Medical/Trip</u> Insurance	If you would like assistance making your travel arrangements, we are happy to refer you to a travel agent who has worked with Maple Leaf guests before. <u>We highly recommend trip cancellation insurance</u> that protects you in case certain kinds of emergencies prevent you from making your trip. Ask your travel agent for information. It may be purchased at the time your payment becomes non-

refundable. Due to the remoteness of the areas we travel in we <u>highly recommend travel/medical insurance that covers</u> <u>possible emergency medical evacuation</u>. Check your existing coverage to see if it's included.
