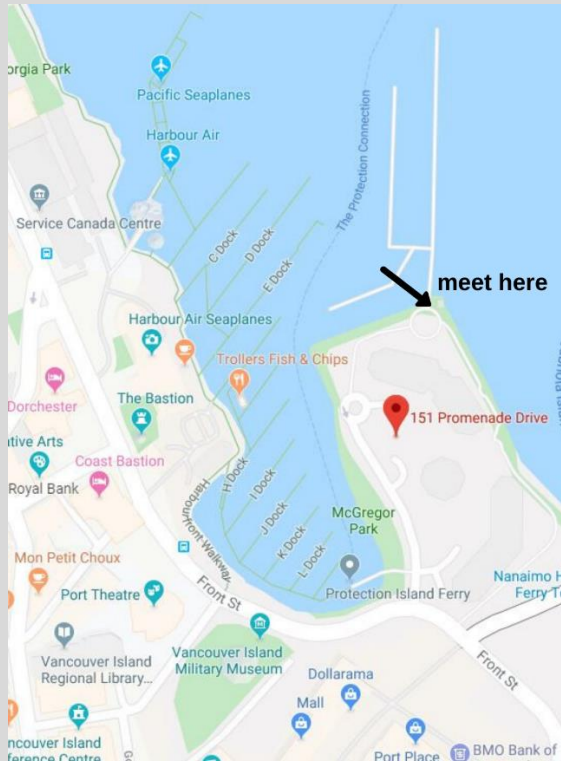

## **Travel Agent and Medical/Trip Insurance**

If you would like assistance making your travel arrangements, we are happy to refer you to a travel agent who has worked with Maple Leaf guests before.

**We highly recommend trip cancellation insurance** that protects you in case certain kinds of emergencies prevent you from making your trip. Ask your travel agent for information. It may be purchased at the time your payment becomes non-refundable.

Due to the remoteness of the areas we travel in we **highly recommend travel/medical insurance that covers possible emergency medical evacuation**. Check your existing coverage to see if it's included.

If you miss the ship's departure time and are able to make phone contact with the Captain, we will make every effort to assist you in finding alternative arrangements to reach the ship. These costs, should they be incurred, will be the sole responsibility of the passenger.
