How To Get To And From The Ship

Important Note About Prince Rupert Airport:

Prince Rupert Airport is located on Digby Island. Included in the price of your flight is a trip on the shuttle bus and ferry between downtown Prince Rupert and the airport. The shuttle will drop you off at the Prince Rupert Hotel.

Refer to <http://www.ypr.ca/> for schedule and shuttle information.

Travel from the airport to the shuttle drop-off takes approximately one hour. Therefore, if you are departing on the same day the trip ends, you must leave at least 2.5 hours before your flight departs.

A cab ride from the Prince Rupert Hotel to where the ship is located takes about five minutes and is cash-only. Skeena Taxi : 250-624-2185

Taxi to the Ship

Prior to leaving for your trip you will need to call to reserve a taxi to take you from the airport to the ship at MK Bay Marina.

Please ensure you tell Kalum Kabs that you are going to MK Bay Marina for a trip with Maple Leaf Adventures. This is so that Kalum Kabs sends enough capacity to the airport for the various airplane passengers' needs.

Travel Agent and Medical/Trip Insurance

If you would like assistance making your travel arrangements, we are happy to refer you to a travel agent who has worked with Maple Leaf guests before.

We highly recommend trip cancellation insurance that protects you in case certain kinds of emergencies prevent you from making your trip. Ask your travel agent for information. It may be purchased at the time your payment becomes non-refundable.

Due to the remoteness of the areas we travel in we **highly recommend travel/medical insurance that covers possible emergency medical evacuation**. Check your existing coverage to see if it's included.

If You Are Delayed And Emergency Contact

These costs, should they be incurred, will be the sole responsibility of the passenger.
